An installation of 'geo-seam' mineral strata paintings, commemorating William Smith's archives and his geological soil map of England and Wales from 1815. The paintings incorporate embedded text from Smith's archives at Oxford University and include the very minerals that Smith described in his pioneering strata map.

Hans-Jörg Hübner, Honorary Consul of South Africa in Dortmund, initiated the exhibition in Dortmund in recognition of the fact that coal extraction in Germany will end in 2018. The exhibition 'Mining - our Heritage | Bergbau - unser Erbe' marks this pivotal moment in the end of the Germany's long and rich mining tradition.
